

MID SHROPSHIRE BOWLING LEAGUE



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THE FOLLOWING IS THE DRESS CODE IN ALL MID SHROPSHIRE COMPETITION FINALS.

MALES

Trousers: These shall be full length, single coloured trousers, in grey or black. Studs, rivets and zipped pockets are not allowed, nor are external pockets on the legs. Nothing in this rule shall prevent exceptions being made for individuals with a relevant disability.

Shirts: These shall be collared shirts which may be embellished with any or all of the following: player's name, Club insignia, County insignia, sponsor's insignia, manufacturer's insignia.

FEMALES.

Trousers, tailored shorts, tailored cropped trousers or skirts, these shall be at least knee length and single coloured.

Shirts shall be single coloured with sleeves and collar, and may be embellished with any or all of the following: players name, club insignia, county insignia, manufacturers insignia, B.C.G.L.B.A. insignia.

ALL

Where necessary, and in accordance with the pertaining weather conditions, sweaters/cardigans which conform to the above and/or wet weather gear may be worn, but correct dress must be worn under wet gear

In team contests it is strongly recommended that uniform clothing is worn by all team members.

Nothing in the above shall be interpreted to allow the wearing of track suits, shell suits, denims or combat trousers.

Any player failing to conform to this standard will be prevented from playing (or continuing) in the competition and may be liable to forfeit any entry fee for, or prize money earned in, the competition

In the case of team contests any offending player must be substituted prior to the commencement of the game. However, if the player's game has commenced, the player shall score nil and the opponent shall receive the maximum score.
